

## Salto Gymnastics Club: Parents/Guardian Code of Conduct

Here at SALTO Gymnastics Club we ask that our Parents/Guardians respect the club, its coaches and the sport of Gymnastics. Please read carefully through the Code of Conduct that we expect from all parents at all times whilst attending SALTO Gymnastics Club.

- > Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.
- > It is the parents' responsibility for the safety of their child before and after gymnastics sessions
- Set a good example by recognising good sportsmanship and applauding the good performances of all participants.
- > Respect the judgement of our coaches at all times
- > Never force your child to take part in sport
- > Appropriate attire;
  - $\circ$   $\,$  No crop tops or similar  $\,$
  - $_{\odot}$   $\,$  Boys should wear a unitard with shorts or a T-Shirt and shorts at all times.
  - Hoodies will NOT be permitted.
  - No zips, buttons, or Velcro
- > All Jewellery must be removed in line with the British Gymnastics Piercing and Adornments Policy
- > Your child should arrive at the club ready to participate in the activity.
- Gymnasts are permitted to ONLY have water in the gym hall we will not allow any form of juice, fizzy drinks or flavoured water.
- > Regular attendance If your child is poorly or unable to attend, please inform reception.
- Share concerns or complaints through the appropriate channels ie. An email to reception, manager, or head coach Not via social media or any other means
- > Use corrects and proper language at all times
- Any use of aggressive or threatening behaviour will result in parents/guardians/gymnasts being asked to leave. You are also accountable for family members/friends that you bring to spectate whilst you are in or representing SALTO.
- Parents and Guardians are not permitted to spread rumours or gossip about matters regarding other children within the club
- Collection of children promptly at the end of sessions and from the designated areas. Do NOT wait in the car or send an older sibling to collect – It should be the parent/guardian or approved adult.
- Please do not allow children to run freely in the car park, they should be properly supervised at all times
- > Respect our club, we will not tolerate any graffiti or mistreatment of our communal areas.
- Respect our spectating area/balcony rules that are displayed in club including videography/photography
- > Your child's fee's must be kept up to date otherwise gymnasts may be refused participation.
- > Membership and Insurance must be complete in full within 2 sessions of starting at the club.
- Inform the club of any medical or additional needs including but not limited to, allergies, regular medication, and extra support needs.
- Keep the club up to date with the correct contact numbers and emergency contact names and numbers.



Parents of SALTO Gymnastics Club must not;

- > Use abusive language.
- > Shout or argue with Coaches, Officials, or other Members of Staff
- > Bully other Gymnasts or children within the Club.
- > Spread rumours or gossip about other gymnasts/children or Coaches.
- > Bring harm to another member of their group/team/squad.

Parents are asked to drive at the designated speed following the road safety signage around the carpark.

Parents must park sensibly and lawfully around SALTO, and not block or ignore neighbouring properties rules.
