Objectives

- Prevent and reduce pollution by implementing efficient control procedures to monitor and manage materials and processes that impact on the environment.
- Implement clear lines of responsibly so that issues can be dealt with at the earliest opportunity to minimise impact.

- Continually seek to improve environmental performance
- Review annually our Environmental Policy & Environmental Action Plans and progress against our objectives.

Environmental Management Strategy

1. Policy

Set a policy with commitment from the highest Board level and cascade throughout the Organisation

2. Environmental Directions

Provide a Policy and Action Plans which identify how environmental initiatives will be achieved.

3. Performance Measurement

Monitor progress by allocating responsibilities that are Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic and Timely (SMART)

4. Organisation

Establish an effective environmental management structure, with key responsibilities identified and communicated

5. Audit and Review

Review the effectiveness of the strategy through regular audits.

6. Action Planning

Identify opportunities for improvement, including the reduction of energy consumption, increase in recycling, and incorporate these actions into the Action Plans
