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Gift Aid 2026

Over the next 2 months we will begin to start working on our Gift aid for 2026. Gift Aid is a government scheme that helps charities receive more money from donations at no extra cost to parents/guardians.

How does it work

If a UK taxpayer donates £1 and chooses Gift Aid, the charity can claim an extra 25p from HMRC, making the donation worth £1.25.

For example:

- Donation: £10
- Gift Aid claim: £2.50
- Total received by the charity: £12.50

This extra money comes from tax the donor has already paid, so it does not cost them anything extra.

What do you need to do?

please log onto your COACHA account and provide us with the information as to whether you are eligible for gift aid or not this is simply a tick box and then saving the information we then can do the rest!
